The new domain name of AFGArea9.org was registered and webhosting setup for the website and member database. As per the WSO recommendations, we setup an anonymous email system using the AFGArea9.org domain name. Our email and document collaboration is hosted by google for no cost. Being a not-for-profit 501-C organization we qualify for their free program.

All Panel 55 officers, coordinators, event chairs, past delegates, trustees, district Dr's and AISL's will have access to and are encouraged to use the AFGArea9.org email addresses provided for them. Some training has been completed for Officers and Coordinators and additional training in the email and collaborating will be offered at the February AWSC and May Assembly.
