Thought Force Topic: Alateen Ideas and Questions from GRs

Background Info: Alateen is part of Al-Anon. It also has some very different requirements and needs our attention in a very special way. Sometimes we are so focused on the necessary day-to-day things we forget some of the more basic questions about our purpose, our willingness, our understanding and our recovery. Perhaps part of our problem with a diminishing Alateen presence is that we have somehow let our old ways of thinking ("I know what's best for you!") to creep into our ideas about Alateen.

Charge: Brainstorm ideas about approaching Alateen in new ways. What changes in the culture have happened in the last 20 years that perhaps we are not focusing on. Does the Al-Anon principle of the 3 A's apply here? (Awareness, Acceptance, Action).

Five KBDM Questions

- 1. What do we know about our membership's needs, wants and preferences that is relevant to this topic?
- We need direct input from teens on how best to help them
- We need ways to build awareness in the Al-Anon membership as well as with teens who need Alateen
- Older people may not be comfortable with using technology that is necessary for young people
- We know we need this, we just don't know how best to do it
- 2. What do we know about our resources (finances, member participation, etc) that is relevant to this topic?
- There seems to be money and commitment, how best to direct it
- Is it possible to get former Alateens involved?
- We know we need more information about money and Alateens
- We have to find a balance between paying for them and encouraging teens to work the 7th Tradition
- How can we use our knowledge to help them reach their goals?
- 3. What do we know about the current realities (membership, culture, etc) and our fellowship's environment (technology, geography, demographic, etc) that is relevant to this topic?
- We don't know anything about Alateen
- We need an information campaign within Al-Anon to tell us more facts about Alateens and Alateen meetings
- We need Alateens to actually participate in Area service
- What are some good ideas about how to be open to teens?
- I believe there is a great disconnect between Al-Anons and Alateens.
- 4. What are the ethical implications of our choices what are the pros and cons? Will our decision be consistent with our spiritual principles?

- There must be discussions of how to use Social Media and technology within the Traditions and Concepts
- Working together we may be able to help keep the teens secure while also allowing new ways of connecting to be worked out
- We know we will need help with the technological side
- Is it possible to get an Alateen to be a kind of Assistant Technology Coordinator?
- We know we need to keep them safe, but how do we do this within the fellowship?
- We have to remember "attraction v. promotion"
- We seem eager to fund all their activities but how does that comply with the 7th Tradition for us and for them?

5. What do we wish we knew, but don't? (use the back if necessary)

- How would the teens like to have meetings?
- Do the judges, jails, schools, etc know about Al-Anon and Alateen?
- How does Alateen differ from Al-Anon?
- Do kids need permission to go to Alateen if it is in a school?
- How do teens sponsor each other?
- What are the similarities between our programs from the teen point of view?
- How can we get more detailed information about how Alateen works now?
- Can we encourage teens to talk about their service work rather than just tell how the family situation has been? Both are valuable.
- How do school meetings and regular meetings differ? How are they the same?
- How many AMIASes are also parents?
- What do the teens think about having their parents in the room?

Ideas and Questions for Alateen Coordinators

- Is it possible to create online meetings?
- Is it possible to create secret FB groups for our Area Alateens?
- What about phone (Conference Call) meetings?
- How can we hear directly from the teens about their experiences in Alateen so that we can better assist?
- Can we rename "Alateen Sponsor" to something like Alateen Meeting Facilitator because it is very confusing.
- What guidance can you give us about going into schools to create meetings?
- Can Alateens sit on Area Task Forces?
- Is there room for a difference of opinion in Alateen? I mean, what about inviting Alateens to come to Al-Anon meetings?
