Well our Phone Volunteer has tested Magicjack for 3 months to make sure it is the way to go. We have been paying around \$70.00 a month phone bill. The initial cost to set up Magic Jack is \$21.15 for the transfer of our phone number. Then the fee for the use of Magic Jack is right at \$40.00 a year. Our AIS Phone Volunteer is willing to come to Assembly and explain this process in more detail to any one interested.

All of our Chairs are keeping very busy. What a great group we have. Our Outreach team has been requested to bring a meeting to a Recovery Facility once a month. Five to ten members get together and take a meeting to the families on family night. They use the book How AI-Anon Works. Another facility has requested them to hold a meeting for their families. This for me speaks of attraction rather than promotion.
