

 January 2017 Chairman of the Board Letter: Pasted below are recent CAL literature decisions from WSO:

The following Interim Actions were taken by the Board during the time period of November/December 2016: In an effort to assist in decreasing budgeted expenses, reduce costs and to apply the use of emerging technology and communication options, the Board of Trustees approved the following recommendations from the Finance Committee:

- **☐** World Service Conference Summary (P-46):
 - The Board voted to accept the Finance Committee's recommendation to discontinue the complimentary printed copy of the *World Service Conference Summary* (P-46) to all World Service Conference (WSC) members, past WSC members, and Area World Service Committee members beginning in 2017. A digital copy will continue to be available on-line. Printed copies will be available for purchase for those who desire a hard copy. The *Conference Summary* will be priced to cover the costs of printing and shipping.
- Complimentary printed copy of the Service Manual (P-24/27):

 The Board voted to discontinue the complimentary printed copy of the Service Manual (P-24/27) in English, French, and Spanish to groups within the World Service Structure beginning in 2018. A digital copy of the most current version will continue to be available on-line to each registered group. Printed copies will be available for purchase. All newly registered groups will continue to receive a complimentary printed copy as part of the registration process.

How Al-Anon Works for Families and Friend of Alcoholics (B-32):
Both as an outreach tool and as a contributor to revenue, the softcover version of How Al-Anon Works is considered a success. Based on these facts, the Board approved to end the trial of selling the softcover version of How Al-Anon Works for Families and Friend of Alcoholics (B-32) as a Public Outreach project within the World Service Structure and to adopt printing the soft cover version in English, French, and Spanish for general sales. The price will remain at \$6 per copy and no discounts offered.

The **2017 World Service Conference Summary** (P-46) typically comes out in August & the new 2018 **Service Manual** (P-24/27) in the early part of next year. Now that the free copies are going away, please be sure to contact your local LDC in advance for any pre-orders of the hard copies you might need for individual members, or at the Group or District level.

- NFA AFG Convention 2017 CAL Workshop: On Saturday, August 26th, from 10:15-11:00am, I'll be presenting a workshop on literature at the 2017 Convention. If groups want to insert any additional pamphlets (or items such as meetings lists) in Newcomer Packets, they'll have to order the other packets that still come in a sleeve: K-18, K-21, K-23, & K-24. Currently, there are no plans to turn those into booklet form. It's just the general packet (K-10) for now.



Courage to Change (eB-16) e-Book Update: WSO is now able to offer this daily reader in English, French & Spanish as one book. You may purchase it from your third-party vendor at \$9.99 US. ADDITIONAL INFO:

- AI-Anon Faces Alcoholism 2018: The deadline to order the 1st printing will be here before you know it! The first printing can be ordered until 5 p.m. ET, Wednesday, July 5, 2017. Magazines will be shipped before September 1, 2017. It's a good idea to set a reminder a few days before so this deadline is not missed because, as stated on the form: "No exceptions can be made."
- District LDC's Conference Call: In July we will be having our last conference call (for this panel) with District LDC's.
- WSO Calendar Quotes for 2018: On April 4th, twenty CAL quotations (in English, Spanish, & French) were e-mailed to all the District LDC's that can be used by Al-Anon service arms in 2018 calendars without completing the currently required reprint permission request form. The only stipulation is that you include the "Reprinted with permission" attribution to the quotation immediately following it & the credit line supplied by WSO. Please contact myself, or your local LDC, if you'd like to get these 20 quotes!

- Sharings Needed for New Daily Reader: As of this April, WSO's Literature
 Committee has received enough sharings to proceed with developing introductory
 text for the intimacy book & the parents/grandparents pamphlet! However, they
 still need more sharings for the new daily reader, for which they have received
 1,070 so far.
- Sharings Needed for "CAL Corner" in The Forum: WSO always needs more sharings about how CAL has helped members with their recovery. Please urge members to write. They could especially use articles about Opening Our Hearts, Transforming Our Losses (B-29), Alateen's 4th Step Inventory (P-64), Hope for Today (B-27), & The Dilemma of the Alcoholic Marriage (B-4). Please contact me directly if you need a copy of the "CAL Corner" sharing sheet.
- CAL Sample Chapter: Each quarter WSO posts a sample chapter of Conference Approved Literature on both the Public Outreach site, www.al-anon.org & the Members' site, www.al-anon.org/members. From April through June it will be *From Survival to Recovery* (B-21). From July through September it will be *Opening Our Hearts, Transforming Our Losses* (B-29).



 The Forum Book (working title): There is still time to submit your suggestion for your favorite Forum article(s) to be considered in the new upcoming book. Have you ever read a Forum sharing that:
