62nd Annual World Service Conference: April 26 – 30, 2022 in Tarrytown, NY

What an experience this year has been for my recovery and also for my spiritual growth. I'm so grateful for the opportunity to participate in the 62nd World Service Conference, in person, in Tarrytown, New York. Meeting in person all my fellow Delegates, the Trustees and all the WSO staff gave me the experience to understand how this program is a fellowship of members with only one purpose, to help family and friends of alcoholics, practicing all the spiritual principles of the program and serving Al-Anon as a whole.



On Thursday, during the week of the Conference, members and guests went on a field trip to Stepping Stones, where we were able to visit Bill W. and Lois W.'s home, in Bedford Hills, NY.

That field trip was a great opportunity for all of us to share time in an informal environment. We laugh and took many silly photos, in addition to the ones taken of this historic place.

The following are the Motions presented during the 2022 World Service Conference:

At the 2022 WSC there were 87 voting members - 1) 66 Delegates (68 areas, but 2 were absent), 2) 11 Trustees, 3) 3 At-Large members of the Executive Committee, and 4) 7 WSO staff. Although the WSC was in person, technology was used to count the votes. They used an application (voxvote) that we all downloaded on our electronic devices. Even though it took a few tests, it was very efficient.

To admit the Non-Panel Global Electronic Area to the World Service Conference (WSC) Structure, whereby the Area's elected Delegate will serve as a voting member of the 2022 WSC as a member of Panel 62.

MOTION #5 - (80 yes, 5 no, 0 abstentions, 2 voids) - CARRIED

To amend the Al-Anon World Service Conference Charter as identified in the track changes document as amended and posted to the WSC Members at 7:00 pm on April 29, 2022.

MOTION #6 - (86 yes, 0 no, 0 abstentions, 0 voids) - CARRIED


To approve the 2021 Annual Report.

MOTION #7 – (86 yes, 0 no, 1 abstention, 0 voids) – CARRIED

To amend the "Social Networking" section on page 127 of the "Public Outreach" section of the "Digest of Al-Anon and Alateen Policies" section of the 2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual (P-24/27) v1 as amended to reflect World Service Conference members' feedback.

2021 Audit Report The WSO received the highest rating possible from an independent auditor, a **clean** opinion. Contributions in 2021 totaled \$2,623,242 which is down 20% from 2020. Literature sales in 2021 totaled \$2,389,064 which is up 3% from 2020.

2022 Budget Report The WSO projects a budget deficit of \$353,114. Total Estimated Revenue \$5,460,061. Total Estimated Expense \$5,813,175 Consistent contributions are still needed to maintain consistent revenue and thus services in 2022. Literature sales are projected to remain below historic levels as groups begin to return to a physical meeting format. The AFG treasurer will be sending out a special appeal letter after the next quarterly appeal letter.



International Coordination Committee (ICC) Formed in 1978 to serve as an advisory committee to the BOT. The next International Al-Anon General Service Meeting (IAGSM) will be held in London, Oct 12-15 hosted by the UK & Eire Structure. Theme: Connecting Hearts and Minds Around the World.

International growth includes new service arm registrations in Russia and Kazakhstan. New and renewed contacts include Dominican Republic, Israel, Hong Kong, Antarctica, Cuba, Greece, and Norway.

Chosen Agenda Items: #1 Rebuilding Alateen after the pandemic. #2 What are the advantages/disadvantages of having both Regional and At Large Trustees?

There was a great discussion on these 2 Items, but what impressed me the most during these discussions is the unity and mutual respect. The discussions took place in an environment that showed many of the spiritual principles of Al-Anon.

Alateen Electronic Group Feasibility What do we hope to learn? What are the current realities of physical vs. electronic Alateen meetings? What are the legal implications? The Electronic Alateen Work Group will continue its research this year and report back at the 2023 WSC.


World Service Conference Site (2023) Announcement

Translation was part of the 2022 World Service Conference

Since Al-Anon is a program in 3 languages (English, Spanish and French), translation was available. At last year's Conference history was made when the motion to make translation available during all future WSCs was CARRIED almost unanimous. This year the translation was only requested by the French-speaking Delegates from Canada. There were 3 professional translators present, alternating during the week, and by the end of the Conference, they were all part of our Conference. As the Delegate from Quebec said, "You don't need to read or write English to be able to serve as a Delegate because these translators were so efficient. Don't be afraid!!".

In closing:

I will like to share with you something that really resonates with me as your Florida North Delegate.

As we enter this new stage of Al-Anon history, there will be many decisions to be made and that will lead to a lot of "talking things over and reasoning things out." In Al-Anon, change does not mean there should be distrust and fear. Al-Anon is a living and healthy program. Our conscious contact with a Higher Power through the group conscience is our unifying strength.

As a Delegate in my Area, the following words from Many Voices, One Journey (page 93) expressed my feelings about being a part of this historic decision made at the 2021 and 2022 World Service Conference:

"I felt an awakening like none other I had ever experienced. There was an undercurrent of excitement-a genuine thrill resonating through us all. I knew my participation in this vote was the beginning of something big. I was witnessing the birth of a critical piece that would guide my home group and all the registered groups to unity."
