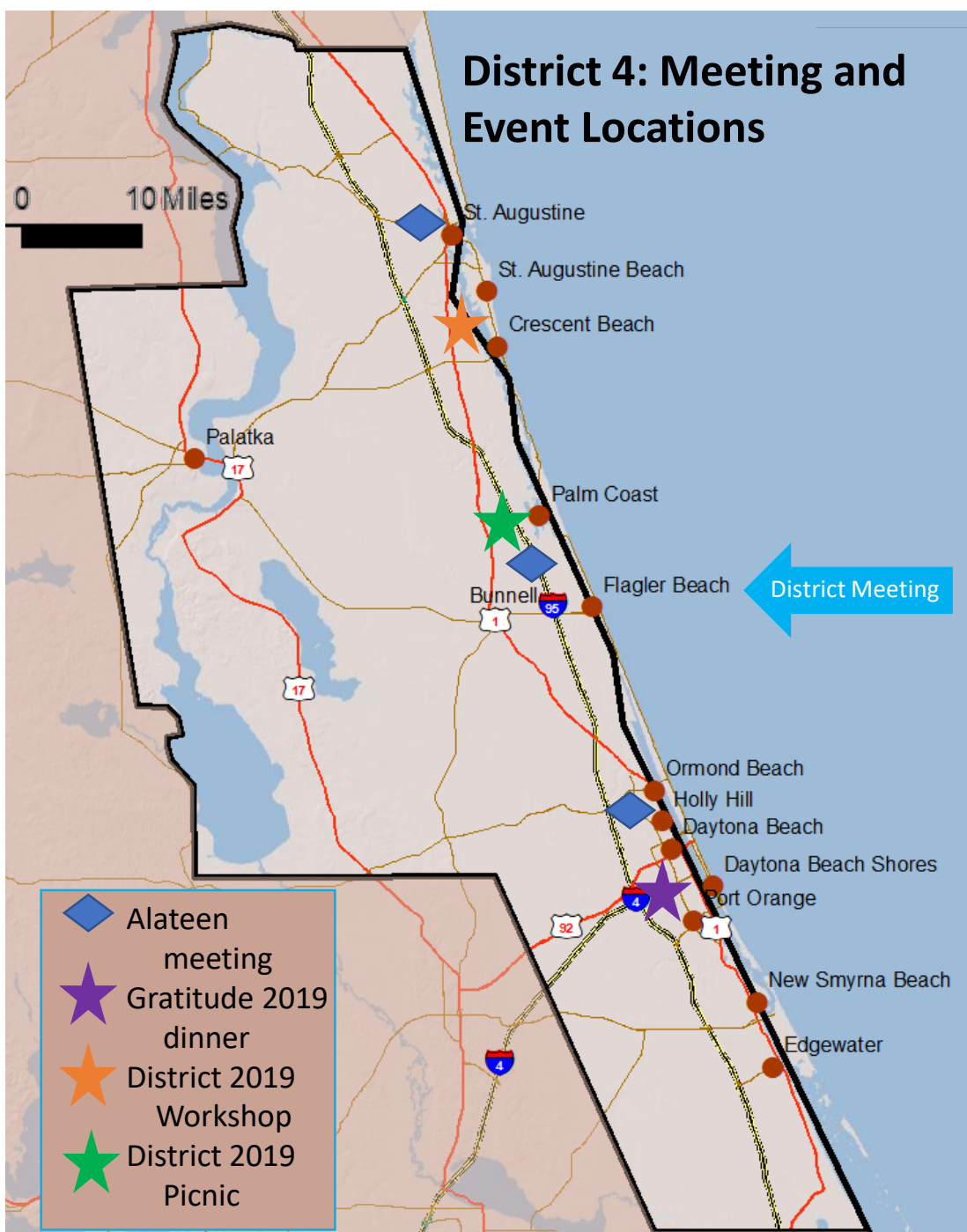

**Things to notice:** District 4 is about 100 miles top to bottom, as “the crow flies”. We have 3 major population centers (*St Augustine, Palm Coast/Flagler Beach/Bunnell and the cities in Volusia county*) and 2 “outposts” (*Palatka and New Smyrna*). We have 35 active Al-Anon meetings and by mid-August 2019 we will have **THREE Alateen meetings!** Although not all of our groups have active GRs, all 35 groups are connected to the District via an email list so they all receive updates on District and Area Activities though email. Average attendance at our monthly District Meetings is about 30. Our District Meeting location is about as convenient as it can get for traveling – being approximately centrally located in Flagler Beach.

**AA Liaison (Dave):** Attended the AA intergroup for the St Augustine area to spread the word about the new Alateen meeting in St Augustine

**Alateen Chair (Sallie):** Our District provided the funds to send 4 AMIAS' and 3 Alateens to the 2019 Alateen Conference in June. Sallie led a workshop at the Alateen Conference called "Taking A Detour" using improv to illustrate the principles of the program. Our District's 3<sup>rd</sup> Alateen meeting will start in August in Holly Hill. Sallie plans to focus getting Alateen meetings in our schools – very exciting!

**Alternate District Representative (Betty Ann):** In addition to regular her ADR duties, Betty Ann has spearheaded a popular program to create "New GR Welcome Binders". The binders are very much appreciated by the new GRs to our District Meeting. She also prepared a report on the wonderful webinars that our Area Technology Coordinator Pat created.

**Archive Chair (Gail):** All district documents are being saved digitally. In addition, Gail has offered to help event chairs search for flyers and other information for planning and guidance.

**Group Records Chair (Heather):** Although quite new to the position, Heather has already processed a GR1 form in addition to the four processed by the outgoing chair.

**Literature Distribution Chair (Margo):** Our LDC is a busy place! The July orders were a record at 18, the previous quarter had 38 orders. \$40 in free literature was provided for public outreach and \$300 was donated to District.

**Public Outreach Committee – report presented by Liaison (Betty Ann):** Our public outreach team has been very busy as well. In addition to providing literature and information at events, we have recently reached out to our local libraries to add Al-Anon books to their collections.

**Where and When Chair (Louise):** Our W&W has recently been reformatted to provide a city/county based organization rather than a daily list. This makes sense for our District given it's size and distribution of meetings –easier for newcomers and long-timers alike to find meetings.

**Insurance update (briefing – Sandy):** Our insurance policy has been continued for another year
