


**CAL for county libraries**: Public outreach continues to be an important component of service in District 4. One of our members, Jane H, reached out to our counties' **public libraries** to provide CAL for their collections. The books that provided are hardcopies of *The Al-Anon Family Groups (classic edition), Al-Anon's Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions (revised), As We Understood, From Survival to Recovery and Paths to Recovery Al-Anon's Steps, Traditions and Concepts.* 

Halifax Health Medical Center Residency Program: Al-Anon was to speak and bring literature to the doctors at the Halifax Health Medical Center Residency Program on September 26, 2019. This has been an ongoing public outreach project by Renee H. who has coordinated with the program director to have two members who will share their stories for 10 minutes each. They will have time to answer questions about how to get in touch with meetings in the community. There will be a table with literature and Where and When's.

Cathy H has been maintaining a presence for Al-Anon at the **Keeping Hope: Overdose Awareness & Remembrance Day – Daytona Beach** by providing literature and answering questions to this Volusia Countywide group.

**Health and Human Services Summit – Volusia County:** held at Maitland High School, Volusia County in October, another opportunity to spread the Al-Anon message of hope and recovery.
