Beginning in January, with our newly elected service positions, we started a new meeting format. District 2 is geographically quite large. We meet monthly on the 2nd Saturday, and decided to alternate among three cities. Gainesville, Ocala, and Lake City. So far, we have held 3 meetings in Gainesville and 2 each in Ocala and Lake City. All meetings have been well attended.

Our new format includes an hour AFG meeting to discuss the twelve steps, traditions, and concepts over three years. We include a speaker on the legacy we are discussing.
