2019 Area Service Workshop Report AWSC February 1 & 2, 2020

Theme: Imagine how you can put these Spiritual Principles to work in your District, Group and family life!

Date: October 26, 2:00 to 6:00 with a potluck dinner afterward.

Location: Queen of Peace Catholic Church, 6455 SW State Rd 200, Ocala, FL 34476

Attendees: There were 75 people who attended the workshop. Every one of our 13 Districts in Area 9 was represented.

Budget: The cost to attend the workshop was \$20. We received \$1000 from the Area and \$300 from District 1. After expenses we were able to make a \$1000 contribution to the Area.

Content: There were three sessions:

- 1. Brainstorming about spiritual principles underlying our legacies: from this activity we created a beautiful word cloud with words representing the spiritual principles of the Al-Anon legacies.
- 2. Applying these spiritual principles to areas of service everyone can do: this activity involved visiting six different interactive stations headed up by six volunteers, each highlighting an area of service, i.e. 1) Chairing a Meeting, 2) Welcoming a Newcomer, 3) Writing for Literature, 4) Volunteering for Events, 5) Public Outreach and 6) Having a Sponsor/Being a Sponsor. Each station collected spiritual principles related to that area of service. This activity produced six unique word clouds, each representing the area of service.
- 3. Panel Discussion about how to bring these spiritual principles to our District, Group and family life: this session included a power point that featured spiritual principles. Selected volunteers took a few moments to share their experience, strength and hope related to the spiritual principles. Workshop participants were able to speak for a few minutes as they felt moved to do so.

Dinner: We provided the main dish, beverages and paper products. Attendees brought side dishes and desserts. We had plenty of food. All the leftover food was donated to a local charity (Thank you to Phillip and Stephanie for delivering the food to the Salvation Army).

Literature and former convention items were sold. Baskets received were given as door prizes.
