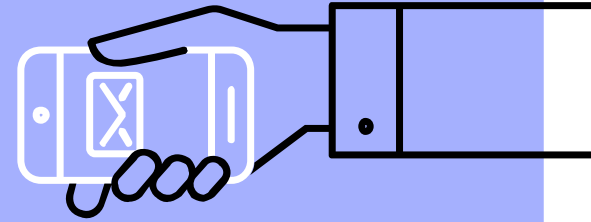

AFTER OCTOBER'S 2018 ASSEMBLY:

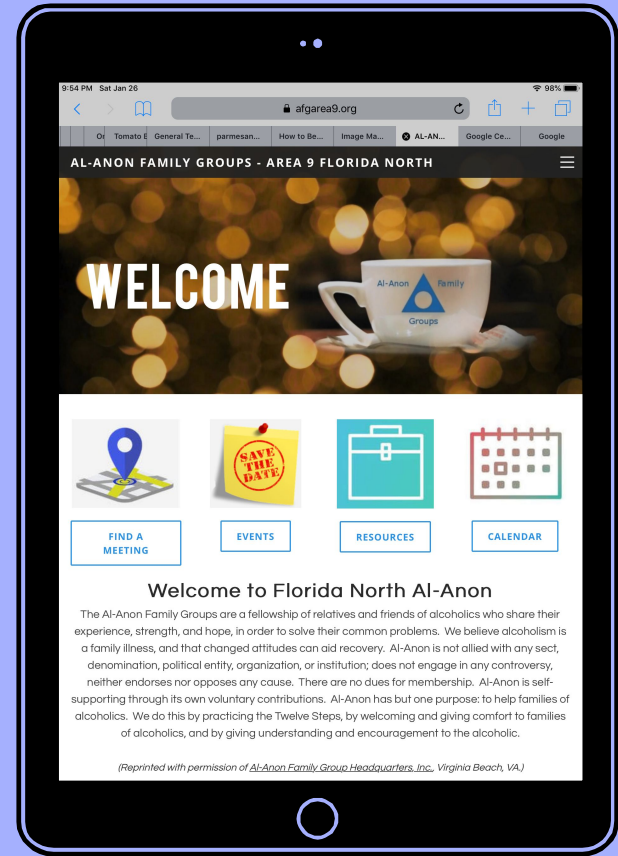
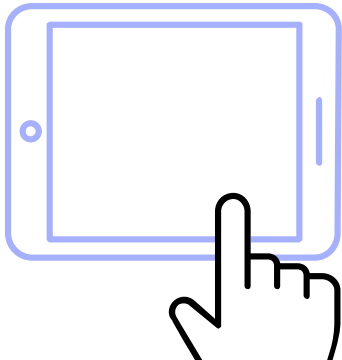
- ▶ All AISL Area email address were switched over to **D**ISL email addresses.

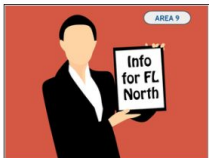
Q1: Why is editing of Group Records Lists by District Group Records chairs not allowed?

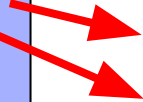

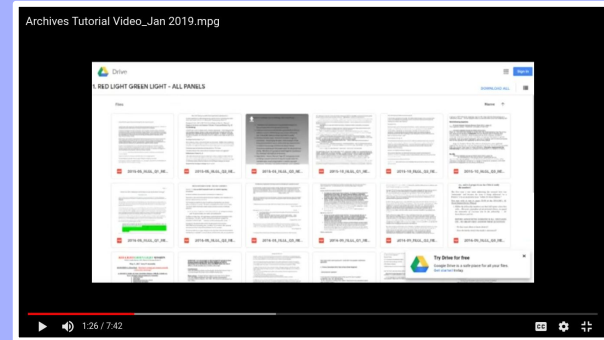

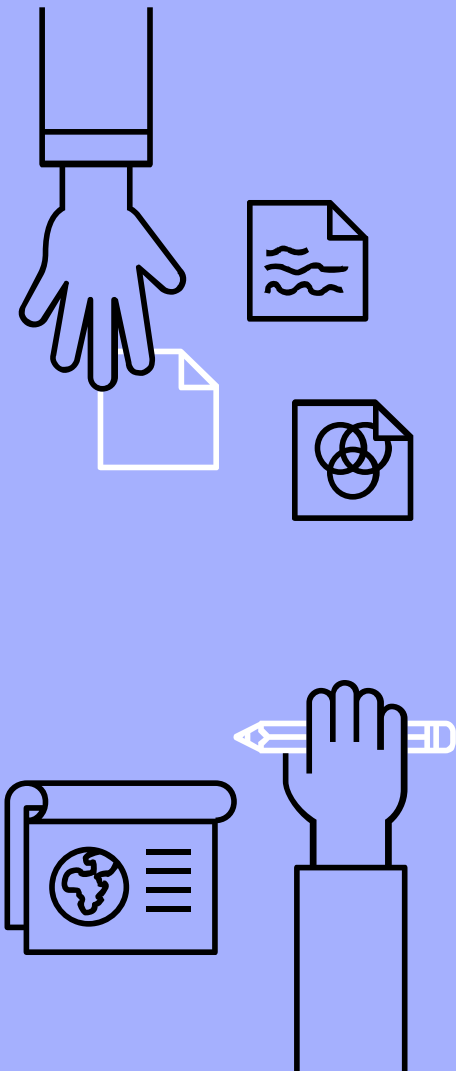
A tutorial video has been created featuring how to search through two new folders.

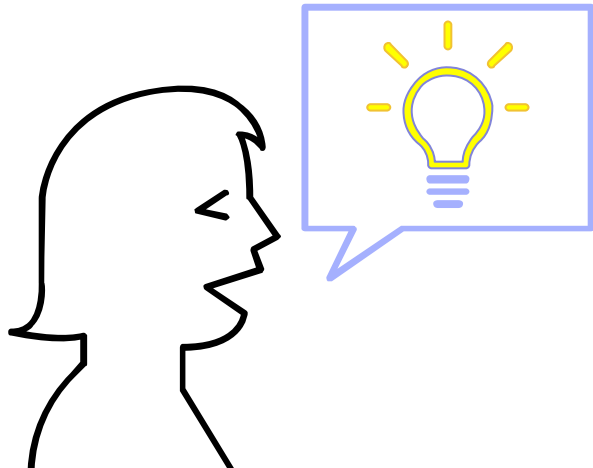

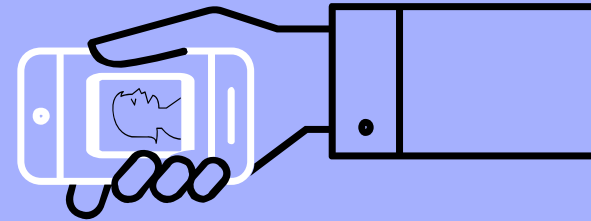
