POLICIES

Policies grew out of questions and experiences from the Area as well as the Al-Anon fellowship. They are interpretations of our basic Traditions and the Twelve Concepts of Service.

FORMS

Forms are blank documents that are not specific to one meeting or event and may not change from Panel to Panel.

AREA 9 CURRENT THOUGHT AND TASK FORCES

THOUGHT FORCES

A Thought Force is a temporary unit of people established to brainstorm ideas and to develop strategies on a single-defined task or activity. A Thought Force may lay the foundation for a Task Force. Members of a Thought Force are thinkers, not doers. Thought Forces use the five Knowledge-Based Decision Making (KBDM) questions to stay on track with brainstorming.

A Task Force is a temporary unit of people established to work on a single-defined task or activity. 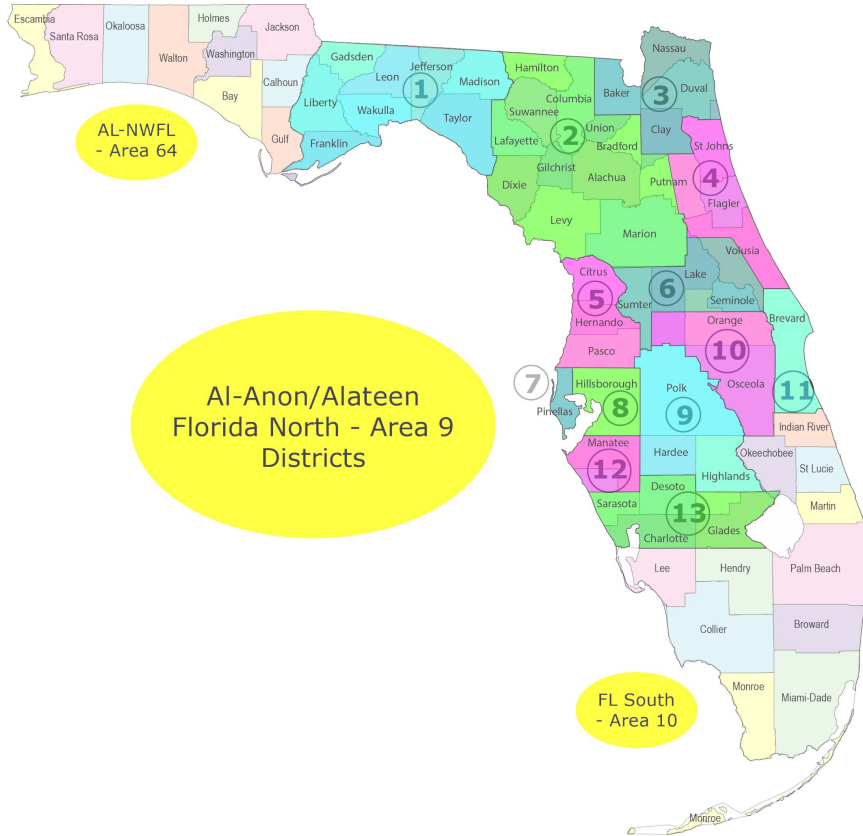

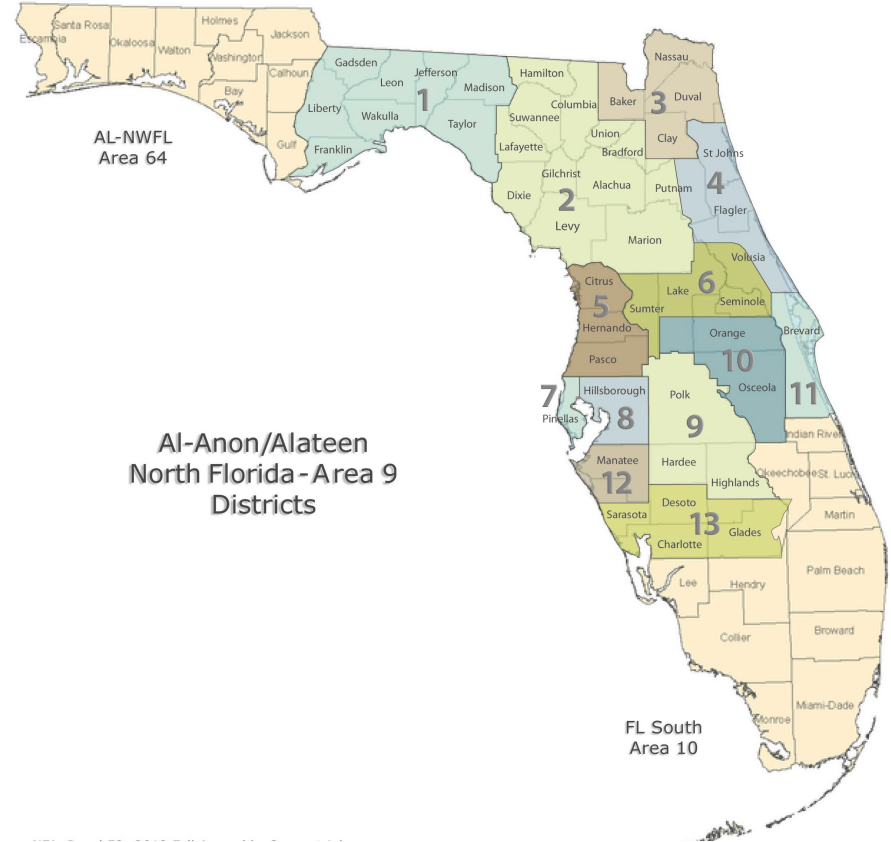
