Where

Set by the Area Chairperson

Length

The meeting should not exceed one hour

Format

- Outgoing Panel members should be prepared to turnover whatever information or tools that could be useful to the incoming Panel.
- If an Area Officer or Coordinator cannot stay for the Turnover, the Area will reimburse for one meal (max \$15) and transportation costs to accommodate an individual meeting at a later date.
