

PANEL 58 DISCUSSION PROCEDURES AT AWSC MEETINGS

We always come from a place of “presumed good will.”

During our discussions please come to the mike if you wish to speak lining up in order.

The Chairperson will recognize you.

The Chairperson, or any other Area Officer, can request to have this discussion tabled and reviewed at another time.

The Chairperson does not enter into the discussion. The Chairperson may answer questions about the issue but not express an opinion.

AWSC members with a voice are allowed “two minutes and one time at the mike per discussion/motion.” When the timer bell rings the member may finish their sentence before relinquishing the mike. When a discussion is held over more than one session, it is up to the discretion of the Chairperson whether or not to allow the one-time mike rule to start over with each subsequent session.

AWSC members are able to come to the mike with a question for informational purpose using their Service Manual. No personal opinions at this time just as question. Members with opinion return to the line of waiting speakers.

If a question is asked, it is the Chairperson’s responsibility to call on the appropriate person in attendance to answer the question.

AWSC members who are designated to answer the question are not limited to the “two minute” opinion guideline at the mike or do they give their opinion. They just answer the question. If they have an opinion again they must return to the mike with a two minute time frame.

In a KBDM culture, we seek information. We do not advocate!

Minority rights are protected as always by Concept 5 (The rights of appeal and petition protect minorities and insure that they be heard.) This is obviously observed at all Area Meetings.

No applause on opinion/applause for accomplishment!!

This is a fragrance free meeting!! Cell phones need to be muted or turned off!!
